All competitors <b>MUST</b> bring their <b>VALID</b> judo membership card to registration. The event has minimum grade criteria detailed below.</p> <p>International competitors must be the holder of a current Membership Licence recognised by their National Federation (IJF affiliate) and which must be produced on the day at booking in.</p>
<b>Age Band: Pre-Cadet</b>  <b>Players born in the years 2009 - 2010</b>	<p><b>Players born in the years 2009 – 2010</b></p> <p><b>Minimum grade:</b> Yellow Belt <b>Contest Duration:</b> 3 minutes</p>
<b>Age Band: Cadet</b>  <b>Players born in the years 2006 - 2008</b>	<p><b>Players born in the years 2006, 2007 &amp; 2008</b></p> <p><b>Minimum grade:</b> Orange Belt <b>Contest Duration:</b> 4 minutes</p>
<b>Competition Format, Rules and Judogi Rules</b>	<p>The intended method of elimination for this event will be knockout with compound repechage.</p> <p>IJF Rules will be in operation. Please note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No 30 second rule</li> <li>• Judogi measurements as per 2022 IJF rules. With the exception of 5cm above the wrist joint.</li> <li>• 2022 IJF Red label judogi rules or the requirement to wear judogi of specific suppliers will not be rules at this competition.</li> <li>• The Welsh Open Championships will be strictly adhering to the mat side coaching rule during the Cadet categories. In the following way: Coaches in the official mat side position can only advise the athlete during the mate-hajime period and <b>NOT</b> while the contest is in progress. Should any mat side coach not adhere to this guideline they will firstly be reminded of this rule by the referee and on receiving the second reminder in the same contest will need to remove themselves to the general public area for the rest of the event on that day. Other personnel who insist on shouting coaching points will also need to remove themselves to the general public seating area.</li> </ul> <p><b>The wearing of white judogi &amp; blue judogi is not compulsory for this event. All competitors must bring have a white judogi available.</b></p> <p>Medals will be presented after each age band final contests have been completed.</p>
